Indonesia is a large importer of cassava starch and starch based products. The rising affluent market and changing diets will further drive consumption of products derived from starch, particularly cassava starch which is considered the gluten free alternative for noodles and

other baking products. It has been tested in laboratories that up to 25% mocaf (modified cassava flour) substitution in instant noodles would not alter the taste and texture profiles of the noodles.

There are plans to revolutionize the cassava industry to build a local market for mocaf. This could be a viable solution to the crops and incomes of the country's farmers for Indonesia.

"Elsewhere, in Vietnam, the Ministry of Finance has turned down proposals by the Vietnam Cassava Association (VCA) for preferential policies similar to those for rice and sugar to ensure its sustainable development"
