The PVC consumption in Russia & Eastern Europe is growing at a rapid pace and investment into new PVC capacity and expansions are underway. However, the availability of feedstocks like VCM could pose a challenge to the intended projects. How are investors addressing the issues, especially acute in Russia & Eastern Europe.

Russia has over 3 million mt/yr of ethylene capacity & expansion at existing plants will result in 30% overall capacity increase by 2010, well below the country's expected needs. How will Russia address the shortage in ethylene & meet the current short-fall? With Russia expected to join WTO in 2007, what are the opportunities available for foreign and domestic players?

With Asia facing a challenging time in terms of PVC oversupply, Russia/Eastern Europe could offer a good solution to the excess capacities. With more export going to Turkey and neighbouring countries from Asia, especially China, how will this impact on the European players? Will further consolidation take place amid global competition?
