The global paints and coatings market is worth \$71 billion/year and Asia Pacific takes up 21% of the pie. "Becker Industrial Coatings has commissioned a larger plant in Selangor, Malaysia to serve burgeoning local market and exports to Singapore, Thailand and Indonesia. A manufacturing plant in Vietnam is also in the-pipeline. Metal Home Digest, Dec 7, '06
