CoalBed Methane Opportunities & Project Sharing Experiences Around the World

Indonesia has the 2nd largest CBM reserves in the world estimated at approximately 453 trillion cubic feet.

Having signed the first CBM production sharing contract in May this year, the Government of Indonesia has said that it intends to sign several more and had put in place a policy framework to attract investments to tap this new source of gas. Many companies are eyeing coal rich Kalimantan region which could lead to development of new LNG projects in the region.

What are the challenges ahead to develop such LNG projects?

On the whole, Asia methane stores an estimated of about 2,100 trillion cubic feet, largely untapped. With the region's appetite for gas growing annually about 2%, can CBM be the answer to Asia's growing gas needs?
