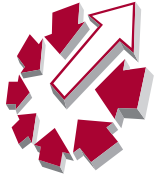

The EU EPR for textiles mandates the compulsory collection and sorting of textile waste by 2025. In order to meet these regulatory requirements, the textile industry must significantly increase its recycling capacity and foster collaboration among different players within the value chain.

Biobased textiles offer a sustainable alternative to conventional fabrics, reducing dependency on non-renewable resources and minimizing the environmental footprint of the textile industry.

Circularity in textiles goes beyond material choices. Design for longevity, reparability, and end-of-life considerations are integral aspects of creating a circular economy.
