In Brazil, due to Covid-19 pandemic, the health ministry has delayed the implementation of a positive list of additives that manufacturers will be allowed to use in food contact materials (FCM). The list, which would align the country with a Mercosur Technical Regulation, was adopted on 3 December 2019 and was set to enter into force on 1 June this year. But in a 26 May resolution, the date for compliance with the new rules was extended to 3 June 2021.

As environmental awareness continues to grow, food manufacturers are under a greater pressure to expand the use of recycled materials in food packaging.
